Dear ISB Community,

We will continue to communicate with our ISB families throughout the coming days to provide additional information about the measures we are putting in place to protect our community through this challenging time.

Two important reminders for our ISB community:

1. We will be asking every family to submit **a self-declaration form** to help us track and monitor if anyone in the household has traveled to or transited through the high risk countries identified by the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Public Health (China, Hong Kong, Italy, Iran, Japan, Macau, Malaysia, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, and Vietnam. **The online form was emailed to families today. The email went to “Person 2” (usually Mother) listed in the PowerSchool database. If you do not receive this form by noon tomorrow, Saturday, please contact Debi Caskey ([debic@isb.ac.th](mailto:debic@isb.ac.th)).**
2. **To provide our teachers, administrators, and staff time to work through some of the operational aspects of the coming weeks, there will be no school for students on Monday, March 2.** We will need time to process the self declaration forms, assist teachers with online learning plans, allow counselors time to address social/emotional issues, calibrate thermal scanners, and to prepare substitute teachers (we will have 20 plus faculty absent for two weeks).
