**Please Note**

Students must be 3 years old on or before September 1st to enroll in Pre-Kindergarten 1. Students must be 5 years old on or before September 1st to enroll in Kindergarten.

Students moving from a different school system with a vastly different school calendar may remain in the same grade level at ISB.

Students enrolling in grades 6-9 (semester 1 of Grade 9) are not placed strictly by date of birth. A variety of factors are considered, the most important being the most recent grade completed/at the time of enrollment. The maturity level, date of enrollment, academic ability, and date of birth are also considered.

Students enrolling in grades 9-12 (semester 2 of Grade 9) are placed according to the number of credits earned to date. Our counselors will convert your child's completed courses to credits. In general, students are placed according to the most recent grade completed and the time of year of enrollment.
