Dear ISB Community,

As we prepare to welcome students back to school on Tuesday, please find below some reminders and updates.

1. Reminder that there is **no school for students tomorrow, Monday, March 2**. Classes will resume on Tuesday, March 3.
2. Every family is required to submit **a self-declaration form before entering campus** to help us track and monitor if anyone in the household has traveled to or transited through the high risk countries identified by the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Public Health (China, Italy, Iran, Japan, Hong Kong, Macau, Singapore, South Korea, and Taiwan). **The online form has been emailed to families with multiple reminders sent to those that have not yet completed the form. If you have not received this form please contact Chad Bates (chadb@isb.ac.th). This form must be submitted by Monday, March 2 at 8AM.**
3. In order to include all of our families and students in Parent Teacher Conferences, we will **postpone the Middle School and Elementary School Conferences scheduled for Thursday and Friday, March 5 & 6 to a later date. That means Thursday and Friday, March 5 & 6 will be a regular school day for all students.**
4. Tomorrow, divisional principals will be sending more information to families about the provision of learning for students under self-quarantine. If you have any questions about your child's learning, please reach out to the appropriate faculty member.
5. Entrance to campus for all of next week (March 3-6) will be **only through the entrance next to the Business Office (6:30am-8:00pm) and the Sarawan Ville gate (adjusted opening times 6:30am-8:00am and 2:00pm-3:30pm, exit**

anytime). This will allow us to complete temperature checks as required by the MoE and other screening measures. **Gates will open at 6:30am and not before.**

Principals will be in touch with home learning information. If you have any questions about home learning, please reach out to the appropriate faculty member, divisional administrators, or counselors.

At present, 4 teachers will be absent from the HS, 3 from the MS, and 9 from the ES.

With respect to students, around 30 will be absent from the HS, 40 from the MS and 40 from the ES.
