Dear ISB Community,

We have very good news to share.

The **Ministry of Public Health has just removed France, Germany, Japan, Singapore and Taiwan** from the list of high risk countries.

This means that those students and teachers who have been at home on self-quarantine as a result of travel to or transit through France, Germany, Japan, Singapore and Taiwan **may come to school as of tomorrow** (Friday 6th March).

The government **still** requires that anyone who has travelled to or transited through mainland **China, Hong Kong, Italy, Iran, Macau, and South Korea** undertake a self-quarantine period of 2 weeks (14 Days) from their return date to Bangkok and not attend school or come on campus until the quarantine period has ended. The quarantine also remains in effect for anyone having close contact with someone who travelled through or transited through mainland China, Hong Kong, Italy, Iran, Macau and South Korea.

Students and staff who are no longer on self quarantine should present themselves to one of the tables in front of school in the morning for verification and a sticker.

Anyone who already has a white ISB sticker on their ID should go directly to the entrance--you do NOT need to stop at the tables again.

1. **Entrance to campus for all of this week (March 3-6) will be only through the entrance next to the Business Office (6:30am-8:00pm).** This will allow us to complete temperature checks as required by the MoE and other screening measures. **Gates will open at 6:30am and not before.**
2. We apologize that the Sarawan Ville gate will be closed for campus entrance this week (except for staff). Vans will be rerouted to the main gate. Parents and students may **exit** the Sarawan Gate gate.
3. The Sports complex entrance will also be closed for the next two weeks.
4. **Parents must bring ID cards** when they visit campus and these will be scanned at the entrance to the breezeway next to the Business Office. We will affix an "entrance sticker" to ID cards and then parents can enter the main campus through the breezeway next to the Business Office. This will enable us to verify if the self disclosure forms have been completed. The sticker and process will be used for campus entrance for the next two weeks.
