Government Update - International Schools

The government announced on Friday last week that international schools are able to open their campuses with a number of safety precautions in place. We are really sad that we just missed the opportunity to see all students on campus again to end this year together.

Opening School on August 10th

With some international schools opening this week, and Thai schools scheduled to open on 1st July, we expect that we can open as scheduled on 10th August. Ideally, dependent on government regulations, we can welcome all students on a daily basis and run school as normally as possible.

Opening Procedures

Please note that we will review and update our opening plans in late July, based on the situation in Thailand at that time and considering any revised government regulations.

Summer Campus Access

Some of our facilities will be open to ISB families over the summer based on government regulations. Starting Wednesday 24 June, the following facilities can be used by ISB students, parents and faculty:

- Tennis courts
- Fields D & E
- Running Track
- Open air gyms
- Reinsch field
- 25m pool (lap swimming only) 12AM-6PM
- MS/HS Library (incl. ES books) - open every Tuesday 8AM-2:30PM (starting 23 June, no appointment needed)

If there is sufficient community interest, we plan to offer summer camps and other organized activities in July (more details to follow).

Virtual Summer School

Our online summer school enrollment has far exceeded expectations and we have 700 students enrolled and mostly full classes. Given teacher availability, regrettably we are not able to accommodate such a large number of students on campus with the social distancing requirements in place. We set up summer school to be hosted virtually and it also means students might not all be in Bangkok
