COVID-19 Update - January 3rd, 2021 - Campus closed till February 1st

Dear ISB Community,

Yesterday, we communicated that the Governor of Nonthaburi had ordered that all schools within the province must remain closed until Monday, 18th January.

Since our message yesterday, the Ministry of Education has declared that schools across 28 provinces, including Bangkok and Nonthaburi, must **remain closed until January 31st** (effectively Monday, February 1st). This order supersedes any directives at the provincial level.

We will run Virtual School starting Monday, January 11th. Divisional principals will be in touch with more information on January 6th.

ISB's administration will host a Zoom meeting for any interested parents on January 15th at 8:00am to address any community questions or concerns. A registration link will be sent in the first week of school.

Please note the ISB campus will remain closed during this time, through January 31st.

We are saddened by recent developments and we will continue to monitor the situation. We hope that students can return to campus as soon as possible.
