ISB Update: 12 November 2021

Dear ISB Community,

We learned that a Grade 12 student tested positive on an ATK test this morning after not feeling well overnight. The test was taken at home and the student did not come on campus today. The student will undergo a PCR test shortly.

The student tested negative on the Wednesday evening ATK test. The student does not have siblings at ISB.

We have completed contact tracing and four high risk close contacts (HS students) have returned home. These students are currently completing ATKs - all negative thus far.

If the student's PCR test is negative then no further action is required. If the PCR test is positive:

- The student will remain home for 14 days
- High risk close contacts will remain home for 14 days (unvaccinated) or 10 days (vaccinated) and undergo testing prior to returning to campus
